Major Tasks Undertaken

CIE continued to work on a measurement tool for reviewing and assessing the level of goal achievement for current GI courses. The following tasks were completed during the academic year that was disrupted by the COVID pandemic, reducing contact of committee members.

- Acquired list of GI courses to review
- Acquired current syllabi from list of GI courses
 - a. Chairs of departments were contacted with a request and a justification for this request, based on current general education assessment model
- Created a rubric for evaluating approved GI course syllabi
- A draft is being generated on the evaluation of GI course syllabi to be reviewed by CIE members on the first meeting of the current academic year and submitted afterwards to Faculty Senate
- Acquired enrollment data in GI courses
- Acquired student grade data for GI courses
- Discussed criteria to evaluate effectiveness of GI courses based on students' performance in these courses
