 - 10,000+ books moved from Currens Hall
 - Re-cataloged/re-labeled/re-located
- Furniture/plants were distributed to other branches
- Realized \$7,173 from sales of withdrawn items/donations through Thrift Books

Cost Savings

Identified ways to save \$161,000 from our Materials budget:

- Cancelled low use journal titles
- Negotiated with vendors to waive 3.9% service fee
- Reduced Chemistry journal and database package while staying within accreditation guidelines
- Cancelled two databases

Gifts


- \$75,321 was raised through pledges, outright cash and planned giving


