LaTeX is a (free) document preparation system for professional typesetting, most commonly used for mathematics and the sciences because of how well it can format special symbols and equations, and reference them. It can be used for writing reports, as well as for creating exams and other assignments.

This workshop is targeted for those who have no prior experience using LaTeX, although everyone is welcome. You will create a LaTeX document that includes sections, equations, tables, figures, and referencing. I will also point out useful menus in an editor and other resources for figuring out more of LaTeX on your own.
