



## Get Your Parking Pass

**Cars:** A parking pass is required to park on campus.

WIU Parking Services will begin selling 2021-2022 parking hangtags July 1. The faculty and staff parking fee will be waived for the fall 2021 semester. Hangtags, which will still be necessary for all faculty/staff lots; however, there will not be a charge for parking for the fall 2021 semester. While the fee is waived for fall 2021, the spring 2022 prorated fee must be paid at the time of hangtag pick-up in July or August. The cost for a faculty hangtag for 2021-2022 will be \$62 (half of the normal full cost). Payroll deduction is a commonly used payment option.

**Motorcycles:** All motorcycles and mopeds must be registered with Parking Services. Individuals who register a primary vehicle and obtain a hangtag permit, may obtain one motorcycle permit at no cost. Individuals who use a motorcycle as a primary vehicle only, will be required to pay the current motorcycle registration fee of \$30 to obtain a permit.

**Bicycles:** Anyone with bicycles on campus must register their bikes with Parking Services. There is no fee to register a bicycle.
