Course and Final Exam Scheduling

The Quad Cities campus adheres to the university final exam schedule and policy. Within the university schedule, the Quad Cities Block and Final Exam Schedule lists preferred class times and outlines final exam times for 16-week, 3 semester hour courses offered in the Quad Cities.

The Quad Cities Block and Final Exam Schedule is used by departments as tool to maximize course offerings and minimize conflicts in student class schedules, and facilitates QC course inventory coordination between programs which benefits students taking classes in general education, their major, and their minor.

Strategic variations to the Quad Cities Block and Final Exam Schedule are possible with coordination between departments and Kristi Mindrup, Assistant Vice President for Academic Affairs – Quad Cities.
