 - Most of the Infrastructure team's work is behind the scenes and not noticeable to end users but want to include some here to reflect how we are keeping things running smoothly and securely.
 - Replacing older unsupported wireless access points with used but still supported models
 - Adding wireless coverage to multiple spaces including the Union,
 Currens, and the WIU farm research plots
 - Working on replacing our Cisco VPN with a new Palo Alto VPN
 - Networking the Kibbe Bunkhouse and connecting its fire alarm to OPS
 - upgraded the hardware of 5/7 of our compute nodes in VMWare
 - Upgrading EoL software, including all Windows 2k12 and older Windows servers and all versions of CentOS servers
 - continuing to install new VoIP phones, now have installs in Sherman, the Union, Horrabin, Garwood, and the Art Gallery.
 - We have moved to installing new VoIP phones when old PBX phones fail instead of replacing old PBX phones
 - in the process of upgrading the mainframe CICS to release 6.1.
 Upgrading all of our CICS utilities first, CICS utilities will take about 1.5 months to upgrade all of them
 - installed a new VoIP server environment using decommissioned VMware servers. This is a big performance and expandability boost for the the WIU VoIP phone system and no extra cost to WIU
