

Types of Aid:

Grants don't need to be paid back and are awarded based on financial need.

Scholarships don't have to be paid back and are awarded based on academic or talent merit, and can sometimes be awarded based on financial need.

Loans have to be paid back with interest.

Work study provides on-campus work experience and a paycheck to use towards tuition or other expenses of your education. To see if you qualify, mark work study consideration on your FAFSA.



How much does it cost to attend WIU?

Making college accessible and affordable is at the core of WIU. We hold some of the same accreditations as top universities at a fraction of the cost.*

*Annual estimates are for a new student enrolling in 15-credit hours for the fall and spring semesters at the Macomb campus with a residence hall double room and a basic meal plan. Estimates do not include scholarships, textbooks, student health insurance, or personal expenses. All costs and scholarships are subject to change by action of the WIU Board of Trustees.

'Necks Steps for Quad Cities

1. How do I apply?

- Complete an online application at wiu.edu/apply
- Pay the \$30 application fee or send fee waiver
- Freshman Admission Requirements
 2.75+ GPA on a 4.0 scale
 3.44+ GPA on a 5.0 scale
- Transfer Admission Requirements
 2.0+ cumulative college GPA
- Send us your unofficial or official transcripts

2. When is the deadline?

There is no application deadline for freshman and transfer students

3. What about my college credit?

WIU reviews credit from any regionally accredited institution all over the country. Students
with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science from any regionally accredited college in the
United States will enter Western with their University General education requirements met and
be guaranteed admission. WIU reviews credits completed through military training, dual credit,
Advanced Placement College-Level Equivalency, and International Baccalaureate programs

4. Official vs. unofficial transcripts?

- WIU accepts unofficial and official transcripts to make an admission decision. Official transcripts are sent directly from each previous school to WIU
- Students must have official transcripts to register for classes and final, official transcripts, on file with WIU prior to the term in which they intend to start classes


